### Air travel to Wakonse

There are no direct flights to Wakonse, but we recommend flying to either Chicago or Detroit and then connect by air to the Muskegon, Michigan Airport. It is then a thirty minute drive north from the airport to camp (near Shelby, Michigan on your map). At the Muskegon Airport, you can either rent a car (if you want to make side trips while at camp) or call camp and ask for a pickup (Phone: (231) 861-2262 and provide flight number and time of arrival). They are only open until 5 p.m. so if you are scheduled to arrive after five, make special arrangements with me at [johnstonj@missouri.edu](mailto:johnstonj@missouri.edu) ASAP. Keeping me informed of your flight plan either way may be in your best interest!

If Chicago or Detroit is not an option for you, look into a flight into Grand Rapids, Michigan but you should know it is a two hour drive from Grand Rapids to camp. We recommend making those plans well in advance, and consider a car or van rental arrangement. The camp will pick you up for a fee if arrangements are made in advance.

### Driving to Wakonse

The best way to get directions is to go online to <http://www.mapquest.com/> and type your Starting Location and then type in Stony Lake, MI 49455 as the Ending Location and you will get a map, mileage and specific directions.

### From Chicago:

1. Take I 94 East to I 196.
2. Take I 196 North to Holland,
3. Then continue North on US 31 to Muskegon, MI.
4. Take US 31 North to New Era Exit [mile marker 140]{Stony Lake Road}.
5. Take New Era Exit (M 20) and turn Left off exit (West).
6. Go approximately 7 miles west to Scenic Drive (4-Way Stop)
7. Turn Right onto Scenic Drive and follow it to the park and Stony Lake Store.
8. At that T intersection, TURN LEFT, and follow it 350 feet and turn into AYF/Miniwanca [before the big stone monument] and check in at the Mills Center (L-shape blue building, double doors – main office).

### **From Detroit and Grand Rapids:**

1. Take I 96 West to Muskegon, MI.
2. Take US 31 North to New Era Exit [mile marker 140] {Stony Lake Road}.
3. Take New Era Exit (M 20) and turn Left off exit (West).
4. Go approximately 7 miles west to Scenic Drive (4-Way Stop).
5. Turn Right onto Scenic Drive and follow it to the park and Stony Lake Store.
6. At that T intersection, TURN LEFT, and follow it 350 feet and turn into AYF/Miniwanca [before the big stone monument] and check in at the Mills Center (L-shape blue building, double doors – main office).

### **From Ludington:**

1. Take US 31 South to New Era Exit [mile marker 140] {Stony Lake Road}.
2. At New Era Exit (M 20) and turn Right off exit (West).
3. Go approximately 7 miles west to Scenic Drive (4-Way Stop).
4. Turn Right onto Scenic Drive and follow it to the park and Stony Lake Store.
5. At that T intersection, TURN LEFT, and follow it 350 feet and turn into AYF/Miniwanca [before the big stone monument] and check in at the Mills Center (L-shape blue building, double doors – main office).

### **Directions from Columbia, MO**

1. Go East on I-70 for 105.9 miles to I-270
2. Go East on I-270 for 15.8 miles to Illinois
3. Go East on I-270 for 15.2 miles to I-55
4. Go Northeast on I-55 for 229.3 miles to I-80
5. Go East on I-80 for 37.4 miles (Portions toll) to Indiana
6. Go East on I-80 for 16.1 miles to I-94
7. Go East on I-94 for 30.9 miles to Michigan
8. Go Northeast on I-94 for 36.5 miles to I-196
9. Go Northeast on I-196 for 50.0 miles to US 31
10. Go North on US 31 for 58.2 miles to State Rte 20
11. At New Era Exit (M 20) and turn Right off exit (West).
12. Go approximately 7 miles west to Scenic Drive (4-Way Stop).
13. Turn Right onto Scenic Drive and follow it to the park and Stony Lake Store.
14. At that T intersection, TURN LEFT, and follow it 350 feet and turn into AYF/Miniwanca [before the big stone monument] and check in at the Mills Center (L-shape blue building, double doors – main office).
15. Approximately 604 miles from Columbia
